Academic Genre

Non-Native Speakers of English

- Master the lexical and syntactical features of the target language
- > Be aware of cultural differences



genre practices, expectations and values may vary across languages

The responsibility for clarity is on the writer rather than on the reader

- have stricter conventions for sections and subsections
- point to "gaps" or "weakness" in prior literature
- present reasonable lexical variation
- use short sentences with less complicated grammar

"authors are expected to take positions and express points of view in acceptable ways"


Why are textual patterns of interest?

Textual patterns facilitate communication by making language more predictable and reducing processing time.

Why are textual patterns of interest?

- Expert writers are aware of the textual patterns most frequently employed by their discourse community and hence make regular use of them
- ➤ The absence of such patterns may be an indication of lack of fluency of a newcomer
